

IMPORTANT! CHANGE IN SMOKING POLICY AT ST. MARON

Following many complaints about the misuse of smoking privileges on our campus, including complaints about smoking inside the restrooms and the finding of smoking materials on religious icons, in the parking lot, on the lawn and in the wood chips and plantings, and after studying current smoking regulations in the state of Connecticut, we have changed the smoking policy at St. Maron.

As before, the use of any tobacco or vaping products is not permitted anywhere inside our buildings. That prohibition is now extended to include anywhere on our property, inside or out. For the present, use of tobacco or vaping products will be allowed inside a personal vehicle in the parking lot, provided the materials do not end up anywhere on our grounds.
