
JOHN 13:31-35

My Dear Friends:

A very happy and blessed Mother's Day to all our mothers, grandmothers, aunts and all women who act as our mothers. Today, while we remember and honor our mothers with gratitude, we should also remember to take time during this beautiful month of May to honor our mother in heaven, the mother Jesus gave to all of us as he died on the cross – his own mother, Mary. Mary loves each one of us as her own child and she is always there to listen to our prayers, to intercede for us with her Son, and to guide us by her words in her many apparitions.

In Catholic tradition, May has been "Mary's Month" for almost a thousand years. Why May? Other months have very important Marian feasts such as her Assumption on August 15 and her Immaculate Conception on December 8. There seem to be two reasons for May, a natural one and a liturgical one.

St. John Henry Newman describes May as a poet might: The first reason is because it is the time when the earth bursts forth into its fresh foliage and its green grass after the stern frost and snow of winter and the raw atmosphere and the wild wind and rain of the early spring. It is because the blossoms are upon the trees and the flowers are in the gardens. It is because the days have got long, and the sun rises early and sets late. For such gladness and joyousness of external Nature is a fit attendant on our devotion to her who is the Mystical Rose and the House of Gold.

In other words, it is a season of light and Mary brought Light into the world; it is a season of joy and Mary brought true Joy into the world; it is a season of beauty and Mary brought eternal Beauty into the world.

The other, liturgical, reason is that May always falls during the Easter season, the season of Resurrection. In the readings during this time, Mary's presence, humble and discrete, is noted: She is with the Apostles in the upper room as they prayed and waited for the Holy Spirit. Pope Benedict XVI says: In the days that followed the Lord's resurrection, the Apostles stayed together, comforted by Mary's presence, and after the ascension, they persevered with her in prayerful expectation of Pentecost. Our Lady was a mother and teacher to them, a role that she continues to play for Christians of all times...

So, today, please pray for your mothers and grandmothers and anyone who has ever acted as mother towards you, and tell them "I love you." And during this month May, this month of Mary, don't forget to tell her as well, just as Jesus did so many times, "I love you."

As always, I pray that God will bless you all abundantly this coming week.
