To continue the series on the Catholic letters of the New Testament, here is a summary of 2 Saint Peter:

Peter knows his death is near, so he leaves a final message for his spiritual children:

- Peter encourages the faithful to "make every effort to add to your faith." Especially in things such as virtue, knowledge, self-control, endurance, devotion, mutual affection, and love.
- Then, Saint Peter warns of false teachers who deny Jesus Christ, exploit others, and live in sin.
- After this, Saint Peter reminds the faithful that God is not slow, but He is patient.
- At the end of his letter, Saint Peter exhorts his children to "Grow in grace and in the knowledge of our Lord and Savior Jesus Christ."

In fact, our goal in life is to grow in grace and the knowledge of Jesus Christ.
