The feast of the Dedication was then taking place in Jerusalem. It was winter. And Jesus walked about in the

HEBREWS 9:11-15

But when Christ came as high priest of the good things that have come to be, passing through the greater and more perfect tabernacle not made by hands, that is, not belonging to this creation, he entered once for all into the sanctuary, not with the blood of goats and calves but with his own blood, thus obtaining eternal redemption. For if the blood of goats and bulls and the sprinkling of a heifer's ashes can sanctify those who are defiled so that their flesh is cleansed, how much more will the blood of Christ, who through the eternal spirit offered himself unblemished to God, cleanse our consciences from dead works to worship the living God. For this reason he is mediator of a new covenant: since a death has taken place for deliverance from transgressions under the first covenant, those who are called may receive the promised eternal inheritance.

blasphemy. You, a man, are making yourself God." Jesus answered them, "Is it not written in your law, 'I said, "You are gods"? If it calls them gods to whom the word of God came, and scripture cannot be set aside, can you say that the one whom the Father has consecrated and sent into the world blasphemes because I said, 'I am the Son of God'? If I do not perform my Father's works, do not believe me; but if I perform them, even if you do not believe me, believe the works, so that you may realize (and understand) that the Father is in me and I am in the Father." (Then) they tried again to arrest him; but he escaped from their power. He went back across the Jordan to the place where John first baptized, and there he remained. Many came to him and said, "John performed no sign, but everything John said about this man was true." And many there began to believe in him.

King Herod persecutes the Church, even killing James, but God miraculously frees Peter from prison through an Angel. In Acts 13:11 Peter says when he recovered his senses: "Now I know for certain that the Lord sent his angel and rescued me from the hand of Herod and from all that the Jewish people had been expecting."

THE MINOR PROPHETS: MALACHI

Malachi is the last prophet of the Old Testament, calling Israel back to faithfulness. He addresses the corruption of the priests, the neglect of worship, and the people growing doubt about God's Justice. He wrote: "For the lips of the priest are to keep knowledge, and instruction is to be sought from his mouth, because he is the messenger of the Lord of hosts" (2:7). In Malachi 3:14, the prophet says: "You have said, it is vain to serve God, and what do we profit by keeping his command." In Malachi's mind, he wants to convey that priests must teach faithfully because God's word is precious. On the other hand, the people must serve sincerely.

In fact, God calls His people to faithful obedience, trust, and integrity, guided by priests who faithfully communicate His Word, confident in His unchanging justice and covenant love.


