1 CORINTHIANS 1:18-25

The message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God. For it is written: "I will destroy the wisdom of the wise, and the learning of the learned I will set aside." Where is the wise one? Where is the scribe? Where is the debater of this age? Has not God made the wisdom of the world foolish? For since in the wisdom of God the world did not come to know God through wisdom, it was the will of God through the foolishness of the proclamation to save those who have faith. For Jews demand signs and Greeks look for wisdom, but we proclaim Christ crucified, a stumbling block to Jews and foolishness to Gentiles, but to those who are called, Jews and Greeks alike, Christ the power of God and the wisdom of God. For the foolishness of God is wiser than human wisdom, and the weakness of God is stronger than human strength.

the time of judgment on this world; now the ruler of this world will be driven out. And when I am lifted up from the earth, I will draw everyone to myself."

St. Carlo and St. Pier Giorgio - Pray for Us!

On September 7, Pope Leo XIV canonized two new saints Pier Giorgio Frassati (1901- 1925) and Carlo Acutis (1991 – 2006). One served the poor of post-WWI Turin; the other coded websites and evangelized from a laptop in Milan. In canonizing them side by side, Pope Leo XIV highlights the Church's universal call to holiness – that all are called to use their unique gifts to reach the heights of holiness.

Both boys came from well-to-do families and both boys had close family members who did not practice their faith. Both were drawn to the Eucharist from a young age. Pier Giorgio once said: *Jesus comes to me every morning in Communion, and I return the visit by going to serve the poor.* And Carlo would say: *In front of the sun, you get a tan. In front of the Eucharist, you become a saint!*

Both boys also went to Confession frequently. Carlo couldn't understand how people are so concerned with the beauty of their bodies and do not care about the beauty of their souls.

In his homily, Pope Leo said: Saints Pier Giorgio Frassati and Carlo Acutis are an invitation to all of us, especially young people, not to waste our lives, but to direct them upward and make them a masterpiece. They encourage us with their words: "Not I, but God," said Carlo. And Pier Giorgio: "If you have God at the center of all your actions, then you will reach the end." This is the simple but sure formula of their holiness.

My Dear Friends:

This week we come to Chapter 4 in the Acts of the Apostles. In this chapter, we see the courage of Peter and John as they proclaim the risen Jesus Christ before the religious leaders who tried to silence them. Filled with the Holy Spirit, Peter declares, "There is no salvation through anyone else, nor is there any other name under heaven given to the human race by which we are to be saved." (Acts 4:12).

Moreover, we encounter in this chapter the life of the first Christian community: "The community of believers was of one heart and mind, and no one claimed that any of his possessions was his own, but they had everything in common." (4:32).

Their example reminds us to stand firm on Jesus Christ with courage, to pray constantly, and to live as one heart and one soul in the Lord.

THE MINOR PROPHETS: AMOS

The book of Obadiah is the shortest book in the Old Testament: Twenty-one verses. Its message is powerful. Obadiah speaks of God's judgment against the nation of Edom for its pride and betrayal of Judah. He reminds us that "The day of the Lord" will bring justice to all nations." At the same time, Obadiah gives hope: God will restore his people, and "The kingship shall be the Lord's" (1:21).

His words invite us today to live with humility, to defend those who suffer, and to place our trust not in human strength, but in God's eternal kingdom.
